The Flu Shot Clinics for the month will be held at the Youth Building at the Crawford County Fairgrounds on Wednesday, Oct. 27, from 9:30-11:30 a.m. and 1-4 p.m., as well as Wednesday, Oct. 20, from 1-4 p.m. The charge for the Flu Vaccine is \$25.
